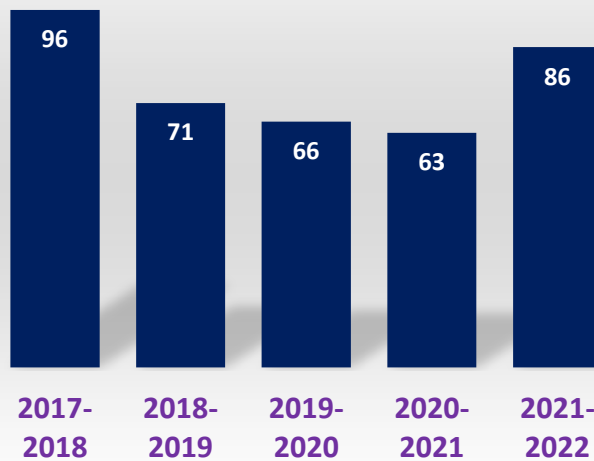

### student Strength 2017-18 to 2021-22

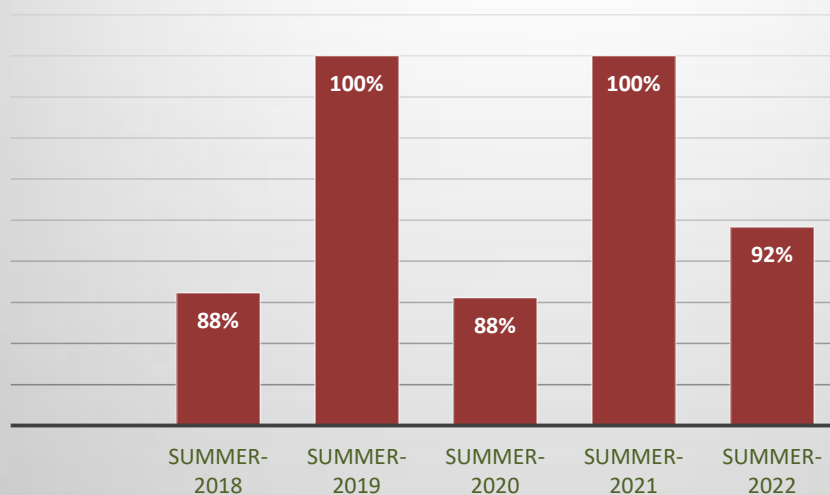
■ Student strength 2017-18 to 2021-22
